Good

- Ematic 7" Tablet 4GB Dual Core - \$39.00 (Wal-Mart online) - This tablet meets the minimum specs. It will be slow but should be workable for this year at least.
 - Double Power 7" Tablet 8GB Memory Dual Core & Bonus Kit - \$59.00 (Wal-Mart online) - Should be a little faster than the Ematic.

Better

- Apple iPad Mini 16 GB (First Generation) - \$199.00 (Wal-Mart online) - Excellent option at a good price. Should be good for a few years.
 - Samsung Galaxt Tab 4 7" - \$169.00 (Wal-Mart online) - Another great option at a good price.

Best

- Apple iPad - starting at \$299.00 (Wal-Mart online) - Good large tablet that should will be very workable. The iPad 2's start at \$299 but I would really suggest trying to get a Retina or above. It will be usable longer.
- Samsung Galaxy Tab - Multiple Prices (Wal -Mart online) - Large variety of options in several sizes and price points.
- Chromebook - starting around \$200 (Wal- Mart online) - This option is the most like a laptop computer. Works great for a student but is really only useable with a network connection. We use them at school due to ease of use and ease of management.
