### Overview of Neuse Charter School

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Founded in 2007, Neuse Charter School serves approximately 935 students from kindergarten to twelfth grade. Neuse Charter offers a challenging college preparatory academic program that adheres to the vision of the school. We, the Neuse Charter School community, believe that through a positive, safe and creative learning environment, students will emerge as respectful, responsible citizens of a global community.

The Senior Academy serves 250 students in grade levels nine through twelve. Students can expect Honors level and Advanced Placement classes throughout their high school career. Students are also provided opportunities to take dual enrollment courses at the local community college as well as honors courses through the NC School of Math and Science.

The Intermediate Academy serves 320 students in grade levels five through eight. Students are offered rigorous coursework in preparation for the Senior Academy as well as accelerated learning opportunities in upper grade levels.

The Primary Academy serves 370 students in grade levels Kindergarten through four. The Primary Academy offers rigor through integrating technology, Spanish, music, art, physical education, and project-based learning.
